NEW Kids Ride Free on NY Waterway Ferries Effective Tuesday, July 5:

- Kids under age 12 can ride on NY Waterway’s ferries for free on all routes between New Jersey and New York City beginning Tuesday, July 5, 2022 through Labor Day, Monday, September 5, 2022. The ticketing policy for the service is: 2 children (max) are permitted to ride free per each paying adult rider.
